



## Organization for the Working Samoyed Awards Program

### Obedience Venue Information

#### Accepted Organizations:

- AKC
- CKC
- UKC
- ASCA

#### Venue Specific Rules:

- A qualifying score (as defined by the organization) is required for points to count.
- All classes which lead to a title are accepted.
- Maximum number of competitions is SIX (6) for the Annual and Most Improved awards, unlimited for the Achievement award.

#### Point Schedule:

1. Normalize Score (so that organizations with different maximum scoring can compete on equal footing):
  - a. Score earned
  - b. Divide by the maximum score possible
  - c. Multiply by 100
2. Take the result from step one and add the number of dogs beaten in the class (i.e. if you earn first in a class of 15 dogs, add 14 points, if you are 10<sup>th</sup> in a class of 15, add 5 points.)
3. Take the result from step two and multiply by **0.70** for Novice (1<sup>st</sup> level), OR **0.85** for Open (2<sup>nd</sup> level) OR **1.0** for Utility (3<sup>rd</sup> level)
4. Take the result from step three and, if High in Trial add 20 points plus the number of dogs beaten, and if high combined in Trial add 20 points. This total is now the points earned for that class.
